The scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior of CHS pursuing a degree in Agriculture. The Scholarship must be used within two years of graduation.

Eligibility

For the individual beginning a program of study in any agriculture field.

- 1) Be a graduating senior of Chinook High School, Chinook, MT
- 2) Is enrolled in agriculture classes or an active member of the FFA program.
- 3) Have participated in school and/or community life demonstrating such qualities as intelligence, self-reliance, energy, imagination, originality, and concern for others.
