Extra and Co-curricular Activities

The District recognizes that the student activities program is an integral part of school life. As such, this broad-based program should contribute to the intellectual, physical, social and emotional growth of students.

The District is committed toward operating all extra and co-curricular programs in a manner that not only teaches the techniques, fundamentals and strategies of the activity, but enhances the social and emotional development of the participants and the spectators.

The Montana High School Association academic regulations state the following: “To be eligible to participate in an Association contest, the student must have received a passing grade in at least twenty (20) periods of prepared work per week, or its equivalent, during the last preceding semester in which he/she was in attendance. If a student is assigned an incomplete in a subject, he/she has not received a passing grade in that subject. The record at the end of the semester is final, and scholastic deficiencies may not be made up in any way.”

In addition to the semester requirement above, students must meet district eligibility criteria as set forth in the district activity handbook and student handbooks.
