Correspondence Courses

The Board will permit a qualified student to enroll in an approved correspondence course from an accredited university, in order that such a student may include a greater variety of learning experiences within the student's educational program.

The classes can be for enrichment and/or makeup. Required classes for graduation can only be made up through correspondence in the event the student cannot possibly schedule the class during the school day. A student might have to pass up an elective in order to schedule a requirement. All independent study classes will be through the State of North Dakota Department of Public Instruction.

Students taking correspondence class will be assigned to study hall. If this is a second study hall, honor pass privileges will not go into effect

The financial obligation of correspondence courses is the responsibility of the student.
