Community and Adult Education

The Board shall encourage and develop adult education programs to meet the needs of the District. The Superintendent shall recommend a director for the program, and the director shall appoint a committee of community persons to act as an advisory group for the adult education and adult basic education programs.

Chinook High School will offer adult basic education and adult education courses each year, to be financed by a levy of up to one (1) mill on the District. Adult education shall be offered for people within the boundaries of Chinook High School District No. 10. Fees are to be set by the advisory council and the director.

Adult education and adult basic education classes may be offered to people outside of District No. 10, at a tuition fee of that class's cost per student, but no less than \$10.00. Adult basic education and adult education classes will be open to anyone 16 year of age or older. All expenses and/or fees for materials will be the responsibility of the person taking the adult education course.
