Health, Family Life and Sex Education

Health, family life and sex education, including information about parts of the body, reproduction and related topics, shall be included in the instructional program as appropriate to the grade level and course of study. The instructional approach shall be developed after consultation with parents and other community representatives. Parents or legal guardians may ask to review the materials to be used and may request that their child be excluded from sex education class sessions without prejudice.
