Student Use of Buildings: Equal Access

Non-curriculum related secondary school student organizations may conduct meetings on school premises, if approved by the building principal.

If the meeting is student-initiated and not part of a school-sponsored activity, it must be conducted according to the following guidelines:

- 1. attendance is voluntary;
- 2. The school will not participate in, or sponsor, the meeting;
- 3. School employees can be present at religious meetings only in a non-participatory capacity;
- 4. The meeting cannot materially or substantially interfere with the orderly conduct of educational activities within the school;
- 5. the school maintains its authority to maintain order and discipline;
- 6. Non-school persons may not direct, conduct, control, or regularly attend activities.

This policy does not apply to non-student groups.
