

Use of School Property for Posting Notices

Non-school related organizations may ask the building principal permission:

1. To display posters in the area reserved for community posters; or
2. To have flyers distributed to students.

Posters and/or flyers subject to a request must be student oriented and have the sponsoring organization's name prominently displayed. Permission will be denied to post or distribute any material that would:

1. Disrupt the educational process;
2. Violate the rights of others, including material that is defamatory;
3. Invade the privacy of others;
4. Infringe on a copyright; or
5. Be obscene, vulgar or indecent.

No commercial publication shall be posted or distributed unless the purpose is to further a school activity, such as graduation, class pictures or class rings. No information from any candidates for non-students' elective offices shall be posted in the school, except on election day, or distributed to the students.

Once permission is granted, the organization must arrange to have copies delivered to the school. Distribution of the material, if it is possible, will be done by the classroom teacher without discussion.
