

## Discovery FFA Degree

- You Must be an FFA member enrolled in Agricultural education class for at least a portion of my school year while in grades 7-8.
- You Must be a dues-paying member of FFA at local, state, & national levels
- You participated in at least one local FFA chapter activity outside of scheduled class time

## Greenhand FFA Degree

- You Must be enrolled in agricultural education class
- You have satisfactory plans for a supervised agricultural experience (SAE) program
- You learned and can explain the FFA creed, motto, salute and FFA mission statement
- You can describe and explain the meaning of the FFA emblem and colors

## Chapter FFA Degree

- You have received the Greenhand FFA degree
- You have completed the equivalent of at least of 180 hours of school instruction in agricultural education at or above the ninth grade level (2 semesters)
- You are enrolled in agricultural education program
- You have a Satisfactory scholastic record

## State FFA Degree

- You have received the Chapter FFA Degree

- You have been an active FFA member for at least two years (24 months) at the time of receiving the State FFA Degree
- You have completed the equivalent of at least two years of school instruction in agricultural program.
- You have earned and productively invested at least \$1,000 or worked at least 300 hours in excess of scheduled class time , or a combination thereof, in my supervised agricultural experience (SAE) program.
- You have participated in at least five different FFA activities above the chapter level.

## American FFA Degree

- Received after the State FFA Degree.
- Been an active member for the past three years
- Record of participation in FFA activities on the chapter and state level
- Graduated from high school at least 12 months prior to the national convention at which the degree is awarded
- Have earned and productively invested at least \$7,500 or have earned and productively invested at least \$1,500 and worked 2500 hours in excess of scheduled class time
