## Supervised Agricultural Experience

An **SAE** is an experience in career and job skills that you need to be an official **FFA** member.

The four major types

- Entrepreneurship is where you're the boss of your business
- Placement is where you are working for someone else
- Research is demonstrate or learn about scientific principals
- Exploratory is where you shadow someone to see if you would like to do that job

Examples for these jobs are

- Live stock production
- Equine Science
- Diversified Crop Production
- Beef Production
- Fiber and Oil Crop Production
- Grain Production
- Taking care of the school greenhouse
- Growing your own plants in a greenhouse to sell at the fair.... **Ect.**
